FireProtection

- Sprinklerandsmokedetectorshavebeen covered/disabled.
- A trained personnot directly involved with the work will provide a continuous fire watch during the perio of hot work and for at least one hour after it ceases in the work area and those adjoining areas to which sparksand heat may spread.
- 3. At least two suitable extinguishers are immediately available. Both the personnel undertaking the work and providing the fire watch are trained in their use
- Personnelnvolvedwith the work and providing the fire watch are familiar with the means of escape and method of initiating an alarm/calling the Fire Department (911 or
